

C. Amendment Summary:

- **What is this amendment about?**

This amendment is to augment Broadband Fixed Wireless Additional (BFWA) Line Rate Data Channel Service. This Amendment will provide an LTE 4G Wireless Data Channel Line Rate option not currently available on the CALNET 2 contract.

- **Why is the contract being amended?**

Verizon Business will be providing the State with services to enhance Evolution Data Only (EVDO) Service by providing greater bandwidth as a tiered level service alternative.

- **What is the reason/purpose for the amendment?**

This amendment is to enhance existing EVDO services to include tier level bandwidth usage on the LTE 4G Wireless network.
