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SUBJECT: CALNET 2 RATE REDUCTION for AT&T Long Distance, Toll Free & International Toll Fee

This bulletin is to inform CALNET 2 customers that the Office of Technology Services (OTech) and AT&T have negotiated price reductions for CALNET 2 services on Master Service Agreement (MSA) 2: Sections 6.2.3 Long Distance Calling, 6.2.10.1 Toll Free Services and 6.2.10.2 International Toll Free Services.

The adjusted CALNET 2 prices are equal to the new lower AT&T CALNET 3 pricing and will be in effect starting June 10, 2014 and continue until customers' CALNET 2 long distance and/or toll free services are transitioned to CALNET 3 or migrated to another serving arrangement.

In addition, as a result of lower CALNET 3 switched long distant rates, the OTech has elected to disconnect the OTech purchased dedicated long distance access circuits that provided many state customers dedicated calling rates. Starting July 15, 2014 all CALNET 2 AT&T long distance calls originally traversing the OTech purchased dedicated long distance access circuits will convert to switched services. The invoices for Customers previously utilizing the OTech purchased dedicated long distance access circuits will reflect lower pricing and a change from dedicated to switched services. This will not affect customers who purchase dedicated circuits directly from AT&T.

The CALNET 2 website has been updated to reflect the new rates.
