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**SUBJECT: EXEMPT STATE AGENCIES - CALNET 3 TRANSITION  
INFORMATION FOR AT&T SERVICES**

In order to facilitate a smooth transition of AT&T services from CALNET 2 to CALNET 3, AT&T had established CALNET service order freeze dates for State customers from 8/1/2014 through 10/31/2014. **Due to the complexity and volume of the transition it has been decided to remove the exempt State agencies from this transition phase.**

A follow up ATR Bulletin will be released to identify the freeze dates for exempt State agencies.

It is Office of Technology's intent to automatically transition all exempt State customers from CALNET 2 to CALNET 3 during the scheduled transition period to avoid disruption and rate increases to customer services when CALNET 2 expires. If an exempt State agency elects to **not** have their services transitioned from CALNET 2 to CALNET 3 it is the customer's responsibility to submit a disconnect order for their CALNET 2 services prior to their transition date.
